At that time, we were all watching on television as young Americans – some severely wounded – were returning to the United States from the battlefields in Afghanistan and Iraq.

Soon thereafter, I officially established the Combat Soldiers Recovery Fund (CSRF), and the first few contributions – a few thousand dollars that first year – were gratefully accepted and presented (100%) to recovering young men and women at nearby Walter Reed Hospital.

2005 was also the year that Million Dollar Baby won four Oscars, including one for Best Picture and one for Best Director for Clint Eastwood. At that time I never dreamed that my own "baby", the Combat Soldiers Recovery Fund, might someday grow up to become a "Million Dollar Baby" itself, but friends, we are now just \$25,400 short of that moment.

Literally thousands of injured service men and women have been touched by your generosity over these past 12 years. Over this time you have given a "Fistful of Dollars" (Clint Eastwood 1964) to help our fellow Americans who have sacrificed so much for our security and our safety. We are all so very thankful for your showing these young men and women that they are not forgotten.
